FORGIVENESS & RECONCILIATION

The Bishop's Retreat for 2019 will be held May 8-10 at Camp Hebron in Halifax, PA. Nestled along the Appalachian Trail just north of Harrisburg, they have 340 acres of wooded sanctuary. Camp Hebron is only 8 miles northeast from the bridge at Duncannon and just a few miles from the junction of Routes 147 and 225 south of Halifax.

We will stay in the Sylvan View all-in-one retreat center, which features 35 comfortable motel-style rooms accommodating up to 4 people each. There is a private bath in each room and linens are provided. The camp has hiking and walking trails for various abilities. Other possibilities include walking the Prayer Labyrinth, a full-size gymnasium, bike riding, and sitting by a campfire.

Our Retreat begins on May 8 at 11:00am and concludes at 11:30am on May 10. The agenda will include worship, prayer, group discussions, conversation with the bishop, and plenty of time for personal and group reflection and recreation. New this year will be opportunities for spiritual direction and massage at an additional cost.

For those who need to update their boundaries training we offer an event on May 7, 9:30am to 4:00pm, with the option to stay over an additional night at Camp Hebron.

This year will feature presentations by the Rev. Dr. Jerome Burce, senior pastor of Messiah Lutheran Church in Fairview, Ohio, since 1994. Pastor Burce joined Messiah in 1994 from previous positions in Connecticut and Papua New Guinea where he was born and raised, his parents being missionaries. He was trained at Christ Seminary—Seminex, an institution that lived briefly in the 1970's and early '80s. He later earned a Doctor of Ministry degree at Hartford Seminary. His key pastoral and theological interest lies in helping people hear and discover how the story of Jesus and the promise of God in Christ arising from that is good news for all of us today. A published author, he uses spare time to contribute text studies and occasional essays to Crossings.org, a website dedicated to reading Scripture and the world from a distinctly Lutheran perspective.

Cost for registration by April 15, is \$306 single; \$196 double.
