Three levels

Constitution

Bylaws

Continuing Resolutions

Model Constitution for Congregations

Required sections: "must be used without alteration or amendment."

- 1. Obtain latest amendments from CWA
- 2. Incorporate CWA amendments
- 3. Determine any other amendments
- 4. Submit amendments to synod for review
- 5. Congregation vote (special or regular meeting)
- Submit adopted amendments to synod for approval

To amend constitution clauses
Two paths

Required clauses (C16.04)

Majority vote if 30 day notice

Others 30 day notice

Two votes:

Majority – 2/3

To amend bylaws

30 days notice

Majority vote

To amend continuing resolutions

Majority of congregation

2/3 congregation council

Remember that all amendments are to be sent to the synod after adoption
