Below is a summary from 2023-24 school year and goals from the 2024-25 school year.

**2023-24 SUMMARY**

**\*Bible Studies** - weekly Monday evening Bible studies focused on topics including idolatry, prayer, temptations, God’s love for us, and many more. Scriptures and prayer were woven into each topic studied.

**\*Community/Campus Service** – UCM participated in the following events: Welcome Weekend for Penn College students, fundraisers for community charity organizations, Rise Up Penn College Praise and Worship event (UCM hosted this event); Williamsport South Nursing Home worship service (UCM students led this service with music, scripture, prayer, and a message).

**\*Campus Support** – UCM requested and received donations to distribute Finals Week “goodie” bags for both fall and spring semesters; held weekly “Jesus and Java” coffee and conversation with Penn College students; Rise Up Penn College Praise and Worship event.

*\*At the conclusion of the 2023-24 school year, United Campus Ministry was awarded by the college for the following: 1) Most Improved Student Organization, 2) Most Philanthropic, and 3) Best Program for Rise Up, Penn College.*

**2024 – 25 GOALS:**

\*Continue weekly Bible studies with guest pastors through UCLC; continue Deep Dive every other Wednesday

\*Continue student outreach opportunities through campus events including Welcome Weekend, student organization recruitment days, weekly “Walk and Witness” time, and campus/community praise and worship events

\*Continue participating in community and campus service projects

\*Continue networking with other faith-based organizations on campus to organize combined worship and campus events

\*Organize a mission trip with UCM students and other interested students to remodel/rebuild homes affected by natural disasters

\*Follow God’s lead in His plan for our ministry
